

## Standing at the Crossroads Keith Walker

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**Jeremiah 1: 4, 5:** <sup>4</sup>The Word of the LORD came to me, saying, <sup>5</sup>"Before I formed you in the womb I **knew you**, before you were born I **set you apart**; I **appointed you** as a prophet to the nations."

**Jeremiah 2:13:** "My people have committed **two sins**: They have **forsaken me**, the spring of living water, and have **dug** their own cisterns, **broken cisterns** that cannot hold water."

Jeremiah 6:10-17: <sup>10</sup>To whom can I speak and give warning? Who will listen to me? Their ears are closed so they cannot hear. The Word of the LORD is offensive to them; they find no pleasure in it . . . <sup>13</sup>From the least to the greatest, all are greedy for gain; prophets and priests alike, all practice deceit. <sup>14</sup>They dress the wound of my people as though it were not serious. 'Peace, peace,' they say, when there is no peace. <sup>15</sup>Are they ashamed of their detestable conduct? No, they have no shame at all; they do not even know how to blush. So they will fall among the fallen; they will be brought down when I punish them, says the LORD.

<sup>16</sup>This is what the LORD says: **Stand** at the **crossroads** and look; **ask** for the ancient paths, **ask** where the good way is, and **walk** in it, and you will **find rest** for your souls. But you said, 'We will not walk in it.' <sup>17</sup>I appointed watchmen over you and said, '**Listen** to the sound of the trumpet!' But you said, 'We will not listen.'

Matthew 11:28-30 <sup>28</sup>"Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup>Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup>For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

1. Four Great Human Longings and Associated Questions: Security (how do I win food and shelter from the environment and stay safe?), Significance (how do I find and make meaning?) Community (how do I get along with others?) and Transcendence (how am I to relate to the total scheme of the cosmos and its Creator? or How is it that I glorify God and to enjoy Him forever?)

- **2.** The Christian's Parallel Calling to Jeremiah's Call: We, too, are formed, known, set apart, appointed.
- **3.** The Prophetic Message Issued to God's People: Two Sins, Moral Muteness, Trivializing Serious, Sacred and Shameless Conduct
- 4. The Ancient Paths (the Good Way GPS): A Sampling of this Metaphor

Trust in the LORD with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding (Prov 3:5). In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight (Prov 3:6). Watch the path of your feet and all your ways will be established. Do not turn to the right nor to the left; turn your foot from evil (Prov 4: 26, 27). There is a way which seems right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death (Prov 16:25). With weeping they will come, and by supplication I will lead them; I will make them walk by streams of waters, on a straight path in which they will not stumble . . ." (Jer 31:9). You will make known to me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; in Your right hand there are pleasures forever (Ps 16:11). He has walled up my way so that I cannot pass, and He has put darkness on my paths (Job 19:8). He restores my soul; He guides me in the paths of righteousness for His Name's sake (Ps 23:3). Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path (Ps 119:105). You scrutinize my path and my lying down, and are intimately acquainted with all my ways (Ps 139: 3). I will lead the blind by a way they do not know, in paths they do not know I will guide them I will make darkness into light before them and rugged places into plains These are the things I will do, and I will not leave them undone (Is 42:16). Make me know Your ways, O LORD; Teach me Your paths (Ps 25:4). For my people have forgotten me, they burn incense to worthless gods and they have stumbled from their ways, from the ancient paths, to walk in by-paths, not on a highway (Jer 18:15).

## 5. Decision Making and the Will of God

God's ways and will are NOT as mysterious as sometimes presented: It is God's will for each of us that we: be saved, be sanctified, suffer, be spirit-filled, serve, be stewards, share, stand, submit . . .

**Romans 12: 1, 2:** Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. <sup>2</sup> Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—**His good, pleasing and perfect will**.

- 6. Invitation from Our Loving God: Come, Take, Learn, and Find Rest
- **1 Peter 5:5b-9:** All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "God opposes the proud but shows favour to the humble." **Humble yourselves**, therefore, under God's mighty hand, **that He may lift you up** in due time. **Cast all your anxiety on Him** because **He cares for you**.
- **7.** Essence of Message: Say "Yes" to Jesus Christ at each and every Crossroad along life's way, at each decision point (large and small) and in doing so: experience His rest for your soul.
